

# L2P LEARNER DRIVER MENTOR PROGRAM



## Join L2P!

The L2P Program is a Victorian Government road safety initiative that aims to help drivers under 21 years of age, who do not have access to a car or supervisor, to gain the on-road experience they need to prepare for solo driving.

Under the new Graduated Licensing System, learner drivers now need to accumulate 120 hours behind the wheel before they can gain their Probationary license.

L2P aims to provide access to driving practice for those learner drivers who may have considerable difficulty in obtaining these hours.

L2P is a community based volunteer program designed to provide access to driving practice on public roads for learner drivers under the supervision of a fully licensed and trained volunteer driver.

This program provides the opportunity in an L2P community vehicle for young people who may be unable to achieve those hours due to a variety of circumstances.

Young people involved in the program will also be provided with a number of professional lessons and training from driving instructors.
